NOBBR Adoption FAQ (Frequently Asked Questions)

What is your adoption process?

An application for adoption is required prior to meeting the dog you wish to adopt. Once the application has been received and approved, NOBBR will set up a home visit for you to meet the dog and introduce the dog to all the members of the family. If you have other dogs in your household we request that a meet and greet at a neutral location is scheduled prior to the home visit. Once your application has been approved and home visit accomplished the adoption is completed by signing a Legally Binding Adoption Contract and paying the Adoption Donation Fee.

What is required for the home visit?

When we conduct a home visit we are looking to see that you have all the necessary things in place for the dog and that all family members are involved in the decision to adopt a dog. NOBBR checks to see you have taken the time to choose a quality dog food; you have purchased necessary items (i.e., a crate, food bowls, leash, collar, toys, etc). NOBBR also wants to ensure that you have set up your home to accommodate the needs of your new family member wither it be a puppy, adult, or a dog with medical needs.

Do you require adopters to have a fenced-in backyard?

A fence is not a requirement. If you do not have a fence, however, you should be prepared to explain how you will exercise the dog adequately. There are some dogs for which a fence will be required based on their temperaments and energy levels. We evaluate these on a case-by-case basis.

What is the Adoption Donation Fee?

The Adoption Donation Fee for all dogs over 6 months of age is \$200 and \$250 for puppies under 6 months of age. Adoption Donation Fee's are used to provide quality care to the dogs in our program, every bit of the fee goes directly back into the rescue to continue to help more dogs. The average cost to care for a dog in our program depending on their medical needs ranges \$400-\$900. The Adoption Donation Fee along with public donations allows us to continue to rescue unwanted, abused, and neglected Bully Breeds.

What is included in the Adoption Donation Fee?

The Adoption Donation Fee includes the dog is spayed/neutered, micro chipped, UTD on all age appropriate vaccinations and dewormings. NOBBR also treats any pre-existing medical condition the dog has when it enters our program. All dogs in our rescue are given premium food and monthly flea and heartworm prevention. Dogs in our program are also crate trained and taught basic commands. NOBBR guarantee's that you will be adopting a dog that is healthy and will make a great addition to your family.

Are adoptions permitted from outside the Charleston Area?

NOBBR allows adoptions out of the Charleston Area. After your adoption application has been approved we will make arrangements for your home visit to be accomplished by a representative from an approved animal welfare agency in your area. Please be advised that NOBBR does not ship dogs under any circumstances and you must travel to Charleston to complete the adoption and pick up your new family member.
